It will run alongside the Regularity run, with start, coffee halt and finish at the same venues, but will be on a different route. The Tour will start at 9:30am, 30 minutes before the first Reg Run car leaves at 10:01am.

The event is non-competitive with no element of timing and is an opportunity for you to partake in a club activity with a social element, including stopping at the finish for lunch. You will be able to buy your own breakfast at the start, and refreshments at the coffee halt.

Although the day has been designed for two people in each car, additional persons may be carried without charge. You will be given an easy to follow road book to take you along our carefully designed route through pretty villages and delightful roads.

Supplementary Regulations

ORGANISATION

1. The Blackpalfrey Motor Club of Kent will organise "The September Tour", a Touring Assembly, on Sunday 13th September 2026.
2. The event will be held under a certificate of exemption issued by *Motorsport UK*, these Regulations & any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. Organising permit/certificate of exemption no. 208554.

ELIGIBILITY

4. The event is open to all members of the Blackpalfrey Motor Club of Kent.
5. All cars must hold a V5 Registration Document, have up-to-date vehicle tax, and have a valid MOT certificate where appropriate.
6. All drivers must hold a valid driving licence for the car being driven. A Competition Licence is not required.

ENTRIES

7. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close on Monday 7th September 2026. All entries must be made on the official entry form and the entry fee of **£30.00** paid via BACS. Each entry will be acknowledged. Final Instructions (including an Entry List and directions to the Start) will be posted during the week prior to the event.
8. The entry fee includes one Roadbook.

10. The maximum number of cars on the event is **twelve**. The minimum is five. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full. Entries will be selected in order of receipt, the running order being decided by the organisers.

ROUTE

11. The event will start from Toby Carvery, Badgers Mount, TN14 7AD. Breakfast will be available to purchase at the start. The morning coffee stop will be at Four Elms Garden Centre, Bough Beech Road, Four Elms, TN8 6ND and we will finish at The Moat Inn, A20, Wrotham, TN15 7RJ.
12. The route will cover approximately 60 miles.
13. The route instructions will be simple – (e.g. In half a mile turn left)
14. The first car will leave the start at 09:30. The others will leave at appropriate intervals determined by the organisers and announced in the Final Instructions.

DOCUMENTATION

16. Cars and Entrants must arrive at the start at least 1 hour before their scheduled start time. The following documents must be available for inspection if required:
 - Driving Licence for the driver.
 - V5 Registration Certificate for the car being used.
 - Current vehicle MOT Certificate for the car being used (if applicable).
17. A basic vehicle eligibility and safety check may be carried out at the start. Any vehicle which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start.
18. All entrants must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event, and they will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at documentation. Signing-on for all participants will take place on-line. The event has no competitive element.
19. Entrants will be given their Road Book when they arrive at the start.
